
Man talk about great timing. Being the middle slot up here is still considered sweet because 95% of all the acts that feature here headline in other rooms across the country. But hey other places don't have Tahoe. Tom Simmons by the way just won the 34th annual San Francisco International Stand-Up Comedy Competition. WOW. What timing indeed! That makes this week really a good one appearing with headliner Nick Griffin. I say this because often times I am quoted as saying, Wow this week is definitely one week to see." But when you have not just two great headliners but two very different points of view than yeah- this week is definitely one week to see. Griffin has been on Letterman already four times since relocating to New York from southern California and I doubt he's going to return anytime soon. Fortunately for us he is in the headlining status this week because for years he was the middle act up here. He started way back at the age of nineteen in Kansas City. After peddling his jokes around the Midwest for a few years, Nick shuffled off to New York City where he did in fact get mugged. Oh sure he still feels insecure about dating and in fact at one time when he used to do some Internet dating when asked how far of a radius was he willing to search for someone would type in 7 blocks. Seven blocks? Nick told me that way if the date didn't work out he didn't have too far to walk if he had to get home. He did have a short fling with British actress Lucy Davis ("Shaun of the Dead" and BBC's "The Office" with Ricky Gervais) back in 2006 (in London for an adaptation of Lord Byron's "The Wounded Heart") but after that project finished Lucy decided it was best to move on. His first major TV late night appearance was on "The Late Show with Craig Kilborn" and can be seen regularly on Comedy Central's "Premium Blend." When Nick decided it was time to move back to New York he promptly landed a spot on "The Late Show with David Letterman" and has since been on there four times. Nick is also a brilliant screen writer having written and/or co-authoring numerous scripts with fellow comedian Mike Ferrucci. As mentioned earlier Tom Simmons has been cleaning up on both the comedy festival and comedy competition circuit. He was a finalist in the 2007 Boston Comedy Festival wreaked havoc in Seattle and this year is giving San Fran a run for its money. Tom has proven himself a solid commodity indeed . Nick Griffin and Tom Simmons in the same week? You heard me and that is happening through the 11th of this new month.

Allan Havey can currently be seen in the hit Matt Damon film, "The Informant!" which stars some ten comedians including The Smothers Brothers, Tom Papa, Bob Zany, Jimmy Brogan and Tom Wilson to name a few. Allan's great in movies and televison ("Curb Your Enthusiasm" was one of my favorites seeing him in) but is very home on stage and very consistently a crack up. Over the years he has appeared on television acting on Seinfeld, The Louie Show and Curb Your Enthusiasm on HBO. I enjoyed the short-lived, "Free Ride" on FOX because it utilized much of his improvisational skills. His quick thinking abilities is what landed him on Ashton Kutcher's realitybased TV show, "Punk'd." He is so convincing it's tough to tell when he's being sincere or not. On the big screen he has appeared in the movies "Internal Affairs" with Richard Gere, "Checking Out" with Jeff Daniels, "Rounders" with Matt Damon, "Wild Things Part 2: The Glades" with Isaiah Washington and most recently in "Hancock" starring Will Smith. On the late night talk show circuit Havey has been a regular on "The Late Show with David Letterman," "Late Night With Conan O'Brien" and cable's Comedy Central and even appeared on Comic Relief. He has taken part in the Just For Laughs Comedy Festival in Montreal on several occasions as well as the Kilkenny Comedy Festival, Aspen Comedy Festival and The New York Comedy Festival. He has made tours of Australia and Europe and continues to be one of the best comedians working today. With all his credits Allan says that entertaining our troops overseas has been the most rewarding. Allan has two CDs out that will be available after his comedy shows. The weather is here and the fishing should continue to improve! October can be one of the best months of the year depending on if we get major weather or if it stays mild. Lake fishing is the one type of fishing that needs the cool weather Once the lakes flop to turn on. (surface temperatures become colder than the bottom and the lake turns over), the fishing will improve. The lakes in particular that need to flop are Heenan. Red Lake and Indian Creek Reservoir. The flows on our local rivers are a bit on the low side but still plenty fishable. The fish know it's time to eat, and are doing so, getting ready for the winter.

Most fly anglers don't like fishing the lakes but lake fishing is one of my favorites this time of the

year! Sight casting to cruising fish along the shoreline can't be beat and can be quite successful and similar to fishing a stream. Create a pathway in your mind that includes about 50 feet out from the shoreline and don't worry about the rest. Most fish will be within this range and cruising looking for Terrestrials or Bait fish. Streamers will work but dry/dropper fishing is my favorite, if the fish won't eat the dry they usually will eat the dropper! Caples Lake is notorious for sight fishing to cruisers and has already begun. Some of the areas worth looking at are the back side between Woods Creek and Emigrant Creek as well as the Dam area and the Spillway area. Midday fishing tends to be the best because of the sun angle and the ability to sight the fish. I have seen fish over 10 pounds cruising the shore this year and plenty of fish in the 2-6 pound range as well. A few flies to try are Big Hopper patterns, Stimulators, Ants, Beetles and things with rubber legs for the surface! Dropper flies to try are Pheasant Tail Nymphs, Zebra Midges, Hares Ear Nymphs and San Juan Worms. If you want to imitate

the bait fish, try fishing a Zonker, White Crystal Bugger or a Maroon Leech pattern.

Tricos and October Caddis are in full swing as well as Baetis, a few Stones and a ton of Midges on the East Carson River. Look for some great action this Fall for those that don't mind fishing for very large stocked trout that eat flies and fight like there is no tomorrow! Fish the sections of the river above Hangman's all the way up to the Highway 4 Bridge. The crowds should not be bad and the fish should be eating well. For those of you that don't mind a bit of hiking and like to get away from the roadside fisheries, take a hike down below Hangman's and experience the Wild Trout section! Pick your poison as far as the hike goes, knowing that the further down you travel the better the fishing will get and the lighter the crowds will be. The water is low so be stealthy and light on the cast for best results! The West Carson still has quite a few fish as well even though the flows are really low. Fish the pocket water below Sorenson's Resort or any of the sections in the canyon all the way down to

the Woodfords area. For those of you that like the challenge fish the meadow but be extra cautious and stay way back from the banks or the fish will be spooked! With the flows as low as they are and the water as clear as it is, these fish really are PHD's!
